# **Arrival Guidelines for First-Time Visitors to Bangalore**

Dear Members,

For those visiting Bangalore for the first time, please find below a set of arrival guidelines to help you navigate and settle in smoothly.

#### 1. Join the NSUB and Relevant Sub-Unit Groups

- Join the NSUB main group and the sub-unit group you belong to. These groups offer vital support such as legal aid, local advice, and peer guidance.

## 2. Respect the Availability of NSUB Leaders

- NSUB and sub-unit leaders are often helping multiple people. Please don't expect airport pickups or lodging unless you inform them at least 24–48 hours in advance and they agreed to it. Last-minute requests may not be possible.
- To be self-reliant do the following below (point 3 to 7)

### 3. Travel in Small Groups if Possible

- Find others coming to Bangalore and arrive together and stick together, the more the better. Arriving as a group is safer and helps the leaders coordinate better.
- It's easier to communicate with one point of contact than several individuals.

#### 4. Consider Pre-Booking Hotels and Cab

- It's a good idea to book your stay at Hotels and airport pickup in advance via platforms like MakeMyTrip, especially if your flight arrives late.

- Other option to book a Hotel or Airbnb for the Initial Stay
- Use reliable services like Airbnb or MakeMyTrip to book your stay. Do not rely on staying at a leader's house unless you have no other option and have informed them beforehand.

## 5. Install Essential Apps in Advance

- Download and set up apps like Uber, Ola, Rapido, Namma Yatri for Auto, cabs, and scooters. These make it easy to get around, especially when you're new.
  - Avoid Unofficial Auto-Rickshaws: Use only trusted apps like Uber, Ola, Rapido, or Namma Yatri to book autos. Street-hailing autos often overcharge 2x to 3x the reasonable fare.

#### 6. Travel & Safety Tips

- Public Buses (BMTC) Buses only accept cash, and fares range between ₹10 to ₹50+, depending on distance. Keep small notes and coins ready.
- Use Technology to Help Yourself, such as tools like:
  - Google Maps (for navigation),
- Google Search (for nearby services), and
  - ChatGPT (for advice and quick answers) is incredibly helpful.
- Don't hesitate to search before asking; it saves time and helps you become more independent.

#### 7. Digitize and Back Up Your Documents

- Scan your essential documents (e.g., ID, college admission letter, Aadhar, PAN, etc) and upload them to cloud storage like Google Drive or any other method.
- Also carry physical copies as they are still needed in many places.

#### 8. Understand the Weather

- Bangalore's average temperature is 24°C.
- It is usually warm here, with temperatures ranging between 15°C after mid night and 38°C during the extremely hot summer days. Heavy winter clothes are unnecessary; bring light, breathable clothing instead.
- It is very rainy here. It rains for 6-9 months on average, with light rains on March to May, and from October to December, but the main monsoon season in Bangalore lasts from June to September.
